



School-Wide Classroom Expectations

1. Follow Directions the First time
 2. Respect Yourself and Others
 3. No Bullying
 4. Keep Your Hands and Feet to Yourself
 5. Be Prepared at ALL Times
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School Wide Disciplinary Interventions

Level 1. Conference

- Step 1: Teacher completes 1st Minor Infraction, Contacts and logs parent call
- Step 2: Teacher completes 2nd Minor Infraction Form, Counseling session with Counselor, Contacts and logs parent call, (Logged into I-Now)
- Step 3: Teacher completes 3rd minor infraction, Counseling session w/Counselor, schedules Parent/Teacher Conference (Administrator and/or Counselor Present), logs parent call, (Logged into I-Now)
- Step 4: Teacher completes major referral (for 3 minors), Counselor Interventions (Behavior Reflections), Contacts and logs parent call, (Log referral into I-Now)

Level 2. After-School Detention (ASD)

Assigned by Administration only!
(Teacher completing the referral will supervise the detention time).

Following the 1st Major Referral

- Step 1: Teacher completes Major Office referral, Counseling session, Student serves 1 Hour ASD
- Step 2: Teacher completes Major Office referral, Teacher schedules parent meeting, Counseling session, Student serves 2 Hours ASD, **Student enters MTSS Tier 2 Behavior (20 day min.)**
- Step 3: Teacher completes Major Office referral, Counseling session, Student serves 3 Hours ASD
- Step 4: Counselor Interventions (Behavior Reflections)

Level 3: Out of School Suspension (OSS)

Assigned by Administration only!

- Step 1: Teacher completes Major Office referral, Counseling session, Assigned 1 Day OSS
- Step 2: Teacher completes Major Office referral, Counseling session, Assigned 2 Days OSS, Counselor schedules parent meeting, **Student Referred to MTSS for possible Tier 3 behavior placement**
- Step 3: Teacher completes Major Office referral, Counseling session, Assigned 3 Days OSS
- Step 4: Referral to Alternative School (At Principal's Discretion)
