- 6. **Pickens** location near 1248 Ebenezer Rd.

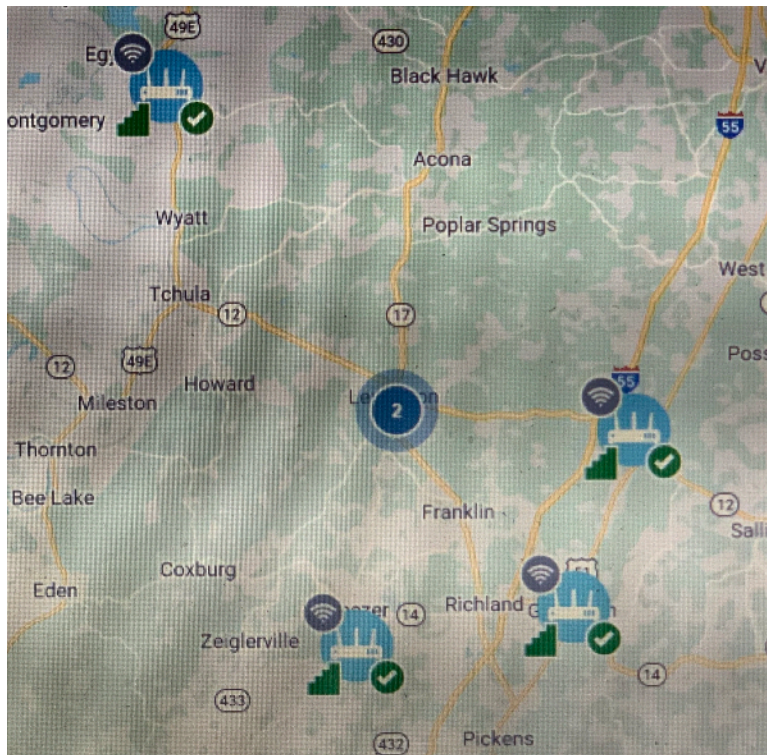
HOTSPOT DISTRIBUTION CONTINUES
