In light of recent developments concerning COVID-19, the Holmes County Consolidated School District is taking proactive measures to keep our students and staff members safe during this time. At this time, the Holmes County Consolidated School District has enacted a District-Wide Closure, March 16-20, 2020. At that time, district maintenance staff and bus drivers will be working to disinfect all school buses, as well as continue to disinfect our school buildings and classrooms. Bus drivers and maintenance staff will report to work at 8:00 a.m. on March 16th and 17th to facilitate this process. All other staff members and students will report on Monday, March 23, 2020.
