The Holmes County Consolidated School District Grade Scale

- Your scholar must earn at least two (2) grades per week.
- These grades will be documented in SAMS Spectra, the online information system for the district.
- Teachers are required to input grades weekly.

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Grading Scale for grades 1-12
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A = 90 - 100 B = 80 - 89 C = 75 - 79 D = 70 - 74F = 69 and below

For Kindergarten the grading system will be as follows:

M - Mastery = 80 - 100 P - Progressing = 63 - 79 N - Non-mastery = 62 and below Pre-K will follow this scale.
