



2022-2023 Goodman-Pickens Elementary Re-entry Guidelines

Daily Safety Protocols

- All individuals will be required to wear facial coverings throughout the school day (additional masks will be available)
- Students will enter through the main entrance of the building and exit through the same; Students will move to the far right of the hall and adhere to spacing/safety signage
- Sanitizer will be required when moving between classes/rooms, after in-class activities and leaving the restrooms at a minimum
- Physical contact will be at a minimum; Large group gatherings will be limited and/or spaced
- Teachers will disinfect desks/tables & chairs after any class change or student movement
- Socially distanced bathroom breaks will be in place; Handwashing will be encouraged
- Temperature checks & hand spraying will be performed prior to entering the building or if deemed necessary through the day; Students with temperatures at or above 100.4F or experiencing significant signs of illness at any temperature will be escorted to the parent center (designated sick room) or the nursing station(as needed). Temperature will be rechecked after 15 minutes. If it still has not subsided, parent(s) will be notified to pickup child
- Classrooms, common areas, and holding rooms will be sanitized daily
- Social distancing in all areas will be enforced
- Students will be situated at least 3 feet apart or behind a plastic partition in classrooms
- Students purposely not adhering to guidelines will have parents notified
- No talking while eating and spaced seating will be situated in the cafeteria; Students may use bottles/cups to drink water
- Only staff and essential personnel will be permitted to the classrooms
- Cafeteria spacing (one seat between) is still required
- All updated CDC, state, and district guidelines will be incorporated as they become available
